Coaches Verification of Meet Rules and Regulations

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES - VOLUNTEERS

- 1) Each school is responsible for **providing volunteers** (see volunteer assignments list) to supervise a field event or assist with the track portion of the event. Any event lacking volunteers will be cancelled.
- 2) **All volunteers must check in at registration** on the field between 7:30 and 8:00 am.

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES - TEAMS Coach registers team between 7:30 and 8:00 am, meet begins at 8:15 am (first call).

- 1) Student participants may participate in **ANY four events** (in their classification). Four name labels have been printed for all students who were pre-registered by their coaches and will be given to coaches at registration.
- 2) **A Permission to Participate form must be submitted at registration for all participating students or the labels will not be available.** Students **CANNOT be added** to the list of participants (no "walk-ons" allowed.)
- 3) Any label that has been altered in any way will **disqualify** the participant from that particular event, unless the label change was made, and initialed, by the meet coordinator.
- 4) Each participant must pin the set of labels to the front or back of his or her shirt (safety pins are included in your packet). As each participant prepares to compete in an event, one of their labels will be removed **by the EVENT SUPERVISOR** and placed on the scoring form. Once all four labels have been removed the participant cannot compete in another event.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- A. **Extent of Participation, Competitors may participate in any four events only.**
- B. **Number of Entries, ALL schools in all divisions will be permitted three entries in each classification for each track and field event; one team entry in each classification for each relay event.** (Note: any entry beyond three in an event will be disqualified regardless of how the participant placed. The mile run limit on the number of runners from a participating school is ten (10) in each category.)
- C. **Relay teams must be composed of four members from one school only, and must be from the same classification.**
- D. **Group Classification Each boy and girl must be in either the 7th or 8th grade category for participation. Sixth graders may participate as 7th graders provided they attend a middle school. A 7th grader may participate in the 8th grade category the entire day after receiving approval from the event coordinator (see event coordinator at registration).**

I have read the above rules of the Harold Pope Junior Relays track and field meet and will review them with my team. All of my team members and I will abide by all rules of the meet.
